RAM

The **F5D**-Packages are created with a maximum of 32 MB. Unfortunately the Kurzweil K2600 comes only with 16 MB RAM. We recommend you to expand your RAM. If you struggle with that, just contact us. We will help you.

Installation

- 1) Unzip the ziped data on your computer.
- 2) Copy them on suitable storage.
- 3) Connect this storage to your Kurzweil K2600.
- 4) Now search for it over the menu to load the data into your instrument.

The time of the loading proceess depends on the size of the file.
